The Jack Leslie Youth Environment Grant is a creative partnership between Youth Central (formerly Child and Youth Friendly Calgary), The City of Calgary and the Leslie Family. The grant recognizes the impact Jack Leslie, former Mayor of Calgary, made to the city and the environment.

Initiated by two programs of Youth Central, the Mayor's Youth Council and the Calgary Youth Foundation, the Jack Leslie Youth Environment Grant recognizes Jack Leslie's achievements and encourages youth in Calgary to continue his efforts.

Projects should be:

- Located in Calgary or surrounding area.
- Directly benefit the environment in Calgary.
- Planned and implemented by youth (we give priority to youth-initiated projects, although some adult support is welcome).

There are funds available for **two** group projects (\$1,000 each) and **one** project from an individual (\$500). We do NOT fund:

- For-profit ventures or individuals.
- Conference fees or tuition costs.
- Projects that will pass our funds on to other organizations or charities.
